



SPORT'S MEDAL PROGRAM

Sport's medal requirements / Eligibility

The following describes the Sports Medals to be awarded, the point requirements and the basis upon which the points will be awarded.

Bronze medal: Within three years a handler must have achieved 20 points in addition to attaining an AD.

Silver medal: Within four years a handler must have achieved 35 points.

Gold medal: Within six years a handler must have achieved 50 points.

All points earned since the formation of the WGSA/Schutzhund Australia Inc. in 2005 are eligible for the Sport's Medal Program.

Schutzhund scoring:

Each of the three categories of competition is worth 100 points. A passing score of 70 points is needed for the tracking and obedience phases, while 80 points are needed to pass the protection phase.

Point ratings are:

286-300	Excellent	(V)
270-285	Very Good	(SG)
240-269	Good	(G)

In order to earn points the dog and handler team must pass with a minimum rating of at least a "G".

How to apply for Sports Medals:

Applications for Sports Medals are to be submitted to the Administrator of Records.

Submit a list of the trials and scores you are including either on an application form or by submitting a copy of your sportpass &/or scorebook/s.

Medals will be awarded to recipients at functions where both handler and a Schutzhund Australia Inc. representative are present. When possible, it is ideal that the medals be presented at the National Banquet.
